Here are the 3 requests/recommendations:

- 1. If you need to test, please reach out to Nurse Ann Hanna and she will guide you as to what steps to take. We are no longer using Sovereign only for the tests. You may choose to use anyone you choose that is appropriate for the test.
- If your student is asymptomatic and needs to get tested for example if flying please be sure it is on Monday morning and keep student and siblings at home until you get your PCR negative results
- 3. Until you get results please have student and siblings stay home as this can potentially have exposure on campus.

If traveling out of state for more than 24 hours, it is a requirement of the state to stay home and quarantine for 10 days without testing and 7 with negative test. Quarantine means do not mean DO NOT meet any other SRDS students. I request to please stay home during quarantine.
